Production started in 1921 and various versions of the Bulldog were produced up to 1960. John Deere purchased Lanz in 1956 and started using the name "John Deere-Lanz" for the Lanz product line. Engine Lanz. oil. 1-cylinder. liquid (hopper)-cooled. 628.5 ci [10.3 L]. Bore/Stroke: 8.856x10.24 linches [225 x 260 mm]. Power: 28 hp@500RPM – 4 forward and one reverse qears.
