The Lanz Bulldog was a tractor manufactured by Heinrich Lanz AG in Mannheim, Baden-Württemberg, Germany.

Production started in 1921 and various versions of the Bulldog were produced up to 1960. John Deere purchased Lanz in 1956 and started using the name "John Deere-Lanz" for the Lanz product line. Engine *Lanz*. oil. 1-cylinder. liquid (hopper)-cooled. 628.5 ci [10.3 L]. Bore/Stroke: 8.858x10.24 inches [225 x 260 mm]. Power: 28 hp@500RPM – 4 forward and one reverse gears.

A few years after the Bulldog was discontinued the Lanz name fell into disuse.
