

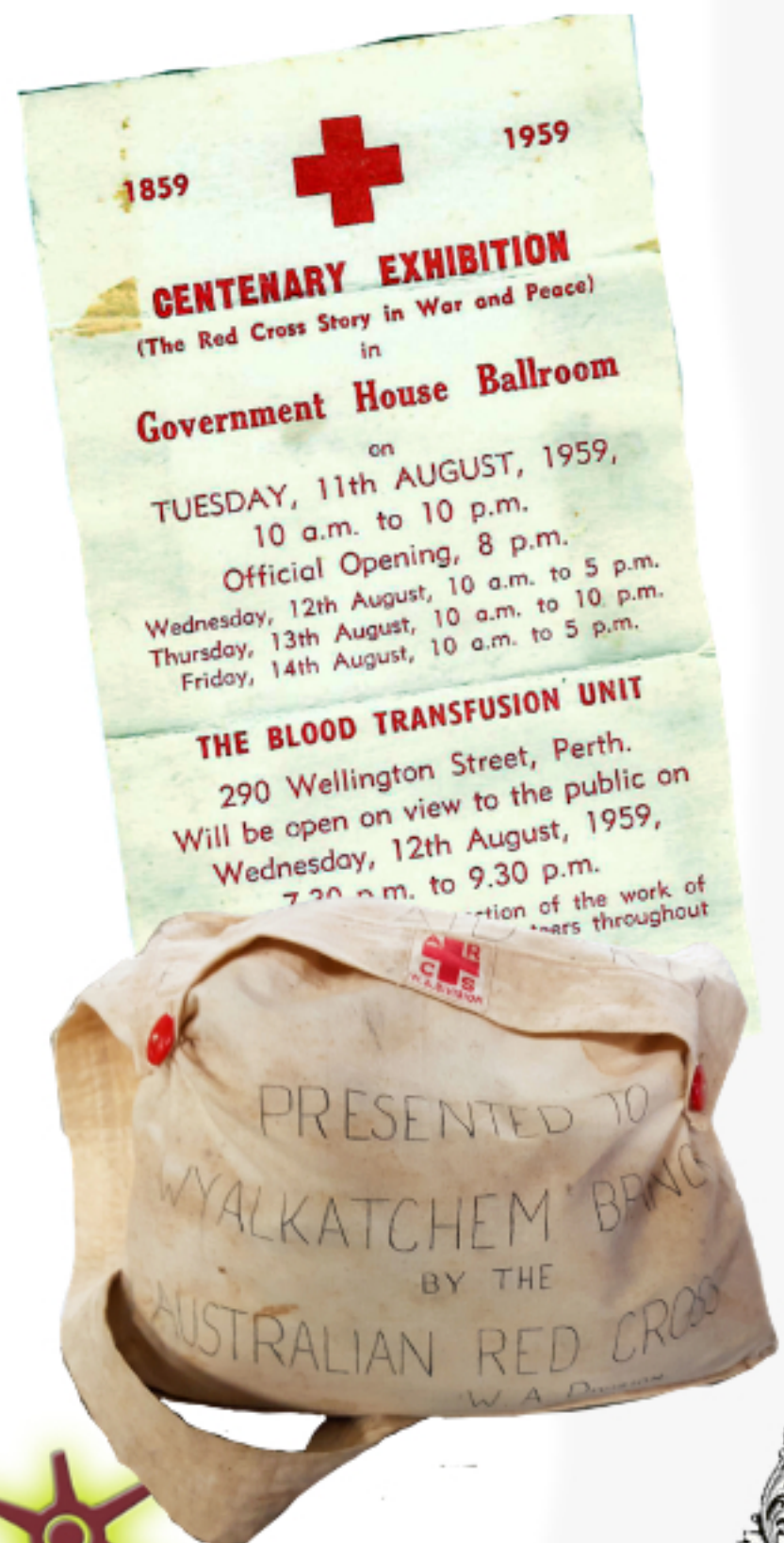
## WW2 First Aid Kit

Gifted to the 'Wyalkatchem Red Cross' which operated out of our CWA building in 1959 when members attended an international "Red Cross Centenary Exhibition" at the Government House Ballroom. The celebration of 100 years of Red Cross was shown through a cross section of the week and 130,000,000 Red Cross Volunteers throughout the world.

Lady Munro Ferguson, the wife of our then Governor General, began the Australian Branch of the British Red Cross Society on August 13, 1914, nine days after the outbreak of World War I. Support for Red Cross was overwhelming, and hundreds of thousands of volunteers signed up during World War I with branches quickly being established Australia wide.
